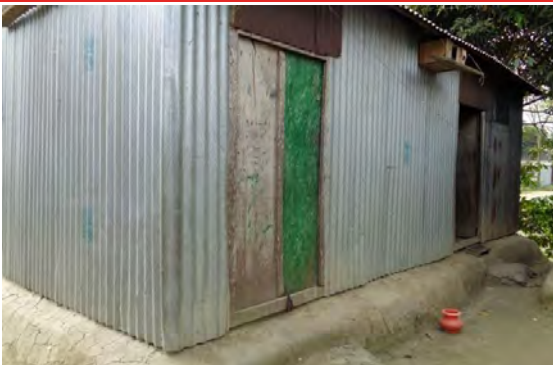

আলোচনাঃ

সভার শুরুতে সভাপতি সকলকে স্বাগত জানিয়ে বলেন যে, আমাদের এই প্রকল্পটি আড়াইহাজার উপজেলার বিশনন্দী গ্রামের মেঘনা নদী (ইনটেক পয়েন্ট) থেকে প্রতিদিন ৫০০ মিলিয়ন লিটার (MLD) পানি (Raw Water) উত্তোলন করে Pipe line-এর মাধ্যমে ট্রান্সমিশন করে রূপগঞ্জের গন্ধর্বপুরে ওয়াসার নিজস্ব জায়গায় নির্মাণাধীন পানি শোধনাগারে এনে তা পরিশোধিত করে উক্ত পানি ঢাকার বারিধারা Injection Point-এ এনে ঢাকা মহানগরীতে সরবরাহ করা হবে। জনস্বার্থে বাস্তবায়নাধীন সরকারের এই প্রকল্পের জন্যে ইতিমধ্যে প্রয়োজনীয় ভূমি হুকুম দখল করা হয়েছে এবং প্রকল্পের কাজকে আরো গতিশীল ও সহজতর করার লক্ষ্যে প্রয়োজনীয় পুনর্বাসন পরিকল্পনা গ্রহণ করা হয়েছে। গৃহীত পুনর্বাসন কর্মসূচী বাস্তবায়নকারী সংস্থা ডেভেলপমেন্ট অর্গানাইজেশন অব দি রুরাল পুওর (DORP) কাজ করে যাচ্ছে। সভাপতি কমিটির সদস্য সচিবকে আলোচ্য বিষয়ের অগ্রগতি ও সর্বশেষ অবস্থা সম্পর্কে উপস্থাপন করার জন্য অনুরোধ করেন।

Introductory speech of Convener: Mr. Bahrul Islam, Superintending Engineer, Deputy Project Director, DESWSP and the Chair of the JVC meeting welcomed the participants of the meeting and commenced the meeting proceedings.

The chair of the meeting described the project in brief before the meeting participants:

The Dhaka Environmentally Sustainable Water Supply Project (DESWSP) will provide reliable and sustainable water supply for the dwellers of the Dhaka City dwellers through developing a new surface water supply mega scheme for supplying pure drinking water, which includes development of a water intake at Meghna River Bishnandi point, the raw water transmission pipeline from Water Intake to Water Treatment Plant at Gandharbpur with capacity of 500 million liters per day (MLD), a treated water transmission pipeline to the existing water supply network, and distribution reinforcements. The project includes distribution network improvements to reduce non-revenue water, and will promote household and community access to safe water, including support to low-income communities. Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (DWASA) is the executing and implementing agency of the project.

For the implementation of this project the necessary amount of land has already been acquired for the project according to the acquisition and requisition of immovable properties ordinance 1982 and Act of 2017 respectively. For a success and smooth operation, the project has undertaken several plans. The implementing NGO is working to facilitate the executing authority to accomplish the project activities successfully. The chair of the meeting requested Mr. Iqbal Hossain, Area Manager of Arahazar and member secretary of the committee to present the meeting agenda.

As the project is being implemented with the co-financing by ADB, AIB, AFD and Bangladesh Government for resettlement plan implementation there is a condition to resolve of any grievance of affected or non-affected person through the process of GRM.

So, those who have any complains need to lodge their complaints with the GRC who will be solve the grievance after scrutiny and analysis by the committee members.

The Member Secretary of the committee informed the meeting participants that the project construction work in section-2 constituted with 24 *mouzas*, comprising an area of 110.32 acres of land has been acquired under LA case 03/2015-16, 04/2015-16, 05/2015-16 and 06/2015-16. Subject to handing over of the land to DWASA by the affected persons the contractors will start installing raw pipelines. He told the meeting participants that in section-2 most of the affected persons have received CCL payment from Deputy Commissioner's office Narayanganj and those who did not receive CCL yet they have legal and other problems. He added that a list of 111 non-title holders names have already been prepared for payment process among which 18 are business tenants, five (5) are textile and power loom factory, one (1) poultry farm, two (2) dairy farm, two (2) residential tenants and 83 are wage employees. At this point the member secretary of the committee requested the committee members to finalize the list of 111 affected persons for payment according to entitlement matrix.

The social Safeguard officer wanted to know the income of the business losers. The secretary of the committee replied to the query of social safe guard officer that the monthly income for each of them have shown more than BDT: 24,000. Based on their income amount they are supposed to pay income tax to the Govt. The member secretary wanted to know from the other committee members that if they fail to submit tax certificate how their compensation will be calculated of fixed. In reply Dr. Rafeza told that they will get compensation as non-tax payer compensation.

The convener and chair of the meeting told to the committee members to check the listed affected persons through field verification on that very same day. All the members agreed to the proposal of the convener. Besides, it was decided in the meeting that the submitted list on wage employees will also be checked in the field and to collect certification from the owner of the enterprise that the wage employees have worked there at least 6 months.

The committee members verified monthly income of 13 business tenants and listed and for the remaining numbers, it was decided to verify on another day.

It was discussed in the meeting how the compensation money and other benefits they have received from Deputy Commissioner's office and DWASA have been used. It was discussed that the compensation and resettlement benefits were given to the affected persons with an aim to reconstruct and rebuild their lives better off and their economic status has positively been changed compared to their present status. Most of them showed interest but few were found to be the hesitant that in purchasing land at the locality or nearby place at a time by a huge number of affected persons will be very difficult. They apprehended that the land price will be abnormally go up. Regarding receiving training under LIRP the participants were informed that under LIRP in the coming days several training sessions on different trade based on the scope of marketing and creating employment opportunities according to and as per the choice/interest of the affected vulnerable and full loss of agriculture based livelihood persons will be organized and provided by DWASA,</p> <p>2. The IGA training will be provided to them basically with an aim to re-establish or restart the loss of livelihood-based activities for enhancing households' income particularly given emphasis on vulnerable women. The INGO assured them that during the project period the INGO DORP, MDSC, Project authority will visit them regularly and during the visit their successes and problems will be heard and they will be given consultancy, the INGO will assist them in involving them with the local level credit institution and NGO's who can provide them technical and financial support.</p> <p>3. In the meeting participants were requested to cooperate with the contractors during project construction work, especially by making free the project acquired land. Some of the participants raised questions that they have not been yet compensated for their lost properties, whether they will receive their payment soon?</p> <p>5. The meeting participants wanted to know how they will receive their compensation money from Deputy Commissioner's office and additional payment/other resettlement benefits from DWASA, whether their payment will be made by cash or by cheque? They also wanted to know the kind of papers they will need to submit to Deputy Commissioner's office for compensation and papers to be submitted to INGO DORP for receiving additional payment/other resettlement benefits. , Their concern whether they will be fairly compensated.</p>	<p>receive as compensation and resettlement benefits will have to be used to rebuild the lost structures and restart their livelihood so that they can bring a positive change in their lives or at least at the level of pre project condition. Affected persons were advised not to use the compensation money/ resettlement benefits in unproductive ways.</p> <p>4. In the meeting with regard to cooperating in the project construction work some participants were reluctant to make free their land as they did not receive payment till then. In this regard they have been notified several times and requested verbally to make the land free for construction work as their land has already been acquired by the Government for water pipe line installation purposes. Their payment has been delayed mostly due to legal problem and lack of mutation according to RS record etc. So, as long their problems will remain unsettled the compensation money will be kept safe in a separate dedicated account opened for them and as soon as their problems will be solved, they will receive their payments. Ultimately the participants agreed to cooperate with the contractors during project construction work, especially by agreeing to freeing the project acquired land.</p> <p>5. The participants were informed i about the papers they needed for receiving compensation from Deputy Commissioner's office such as ownership document of the land, updated mutation and land tax receipt, national ID card, bank account number etc. The participants were informed that they will be paid by account payee cheque. The affected members, who are facing issues regarding the ownership of lands or due to some other reasons, they have not received the payments from the Deputy Commissioner's office or from the project office, they asked the project authority about payment. They mentioned that some cases are in the legal court and some are mutation cases and shareholders problem and some with ownership problem, they need record correction. So, their question was how they will receive their payment, The meeting participants requested the authority to help them in pursuing their cases and to get the mutation</p>	<p>payment and other resettlement benefits, the participants were informed that they will receive additional payment according to the current market value and according to the project entitlement matrix. INGO DORP will assist/guide them in preparing/collecting necessary papers to be submitted to DWASA for receiving additional payment and other resettlement benefits. In response to the question whether the project affected persons will be paid by cash or by cheque, they were informed that the payment will be made in account payee cheque. In this regard they need to open individual bank account. In reply to another question they have been informed that DORP will try their utmost to ensure fair and transparent payment.</p> <p>In response to the participants question they were informed that those have already been received CCL from Deputy Commissioner's office, all those papers along with affected persons ID card, Photocopy of NID/SMART card, citizenship certificate from Union/Pauroshava Chairman, account number, share sheet etc. to be submitted to DORP local office for payment of additional/resettlement benefits.</p> <p>6. In the meeting in response to the questions raised by the participants they were informed that those affected persons, who are facing issues regarding the ownership of lands or due to some other reasons, did not receive the payments from the Deputy Commissioner's office or from the project office, their money will be safely kept to the account of Deputy Commissioner's office and at the DWASA Project Office separately by opening an dedicated account. Based on the circumstances, even after the project is over, the money will be kept safe in the dedicated account. On the basis of discussion of the topic the participants asked whether they will be paid their compensation before shifting of their structures. Unless they are paid fully, they will not shift their structures and will not make the project area free for project construction work. The participants insisted that they must be paid all their dues and sufficient notice to be given to allow them reasonable time for shifting, otherwise they will not hand over their land or remove their structures etc.</p> <p>8.
